The Division of Biostatistics in the School of Public Health at Yale University is accepting applications for the position of Assistant or Associate Professor. Applicants should have a Ph.D. in statistics, biostatistics, or a closely related field. Preference will be given to relatively recent graduates and to those with experience in the development and application of statistical methodology for the design and analysis of clinical trials. The selected candidate will be expected to be an effective teacher and collaborator, and will conduct an independent program of methodological research on the design and/or analysis of clinical trials.

In filling this position, the Division of Biostatistics and the VA Connecticut Healthcare System in West Haven, CT seek to expand their research program on methods for improving the conduct of multicenter clinical trials. This faculty position will be based at the VA, with an academic appointment at Yale University School of Public Health. The candidate filling this position will have the opportunity to lead a strong research program that utilizes the data and infrastructure of the VA system, and he/she will actively participate in the research activities of the Cooperative Studies Program (a national network of biostatistical and epidemiological research centers).
